

Services for 504 Students

Student Service Delivery Expectations

Once the student has qualified under §504 guidelines, schools are expected to:

- continue student instruction in the District's curriculum and provide direct, explicit instruction to the student as needed;
- implement an individual plan which outlines instruction interventions and monitor the student's progress;
- provide direct instruction to identified dyslexic students by a teacher trained the district approved dyslexia curriculum;
- ensure all the student's teachers are aware of and implement the accommodations indicated on the student's individualized 504 plan;
- include the student in enrichment and supplementary activities as appropriate, such as tutoring, etc.;
- monitor the student's progress on a regular basis to ensure achievement;
- maintain regular contact with the student's parents regarding the student's achievement; and
- contact the campus and/or district 504/Dyslexia coordinator if you need assistance in planning the student's instructional program, training teachers, or problem solving.
