**16<sup>th</sup> – I** (Income tax)

**17<sup>th</sup> – D** (Direct election of senators)

**18<sup>th</sup> – P** (Prohibition)

**19<sup>th</sup> – W** (Women’s right to vote [suffrage])

**24<sup>th</sup> – ~~Poll~~** (Poll tax eliminated)

**26<sup>th</sup> – 18** (Voting rights for 18 year olds)
