## Introduction:

We have heard the quote at one time or another that a picture is "worth a thousand words." Professional photographers use the camera to capture emotions and convey feelings of the audience. We are going to look at the power of images in this lesson.

## Directions:

- 1. Your teacher is going to assign a topic for you to do some research on. You will, however, be mainly searching for pictures.**
- 2. Use Google's Image Search Engine to look for pictures that have to do with your topic. If you are having trouble finding pictures, you may want to search using different words that have the same meaning or context as your topic. For an example, if you are looking pictures for the flag, trying using "American flag," "star spangled banner," or even "old glory" to find your images.**
- 3. Save the images from the Internet into one folder on your computer. Make sure that you get the website's information so you can site your source.**
- 4. Gather your saved pictures and create a slide show presentation demonstrating how the images relate to your topic. You can narrate your presentation and even have music playing to enhance the message of the pictures.**
