## *Invitation to Celebrate*

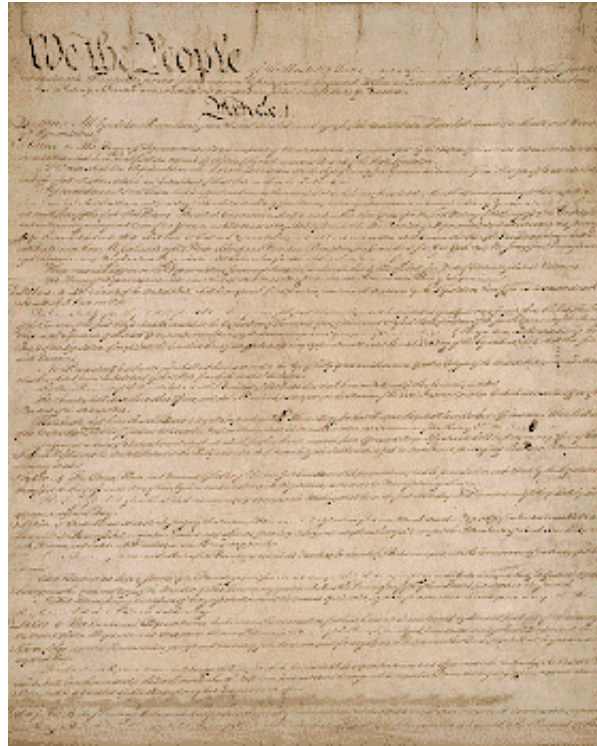
