Safety & Security Improvements

- Improve campus security and access control with additional security cameras, new building access cards and readers for faculty and staff
- Repair and update existing PA system, emergency fire alarm system, and fire sprinkler system in campus
- Improve special-needs accessibility issues
- Improve site lighting and fences

Technology Improvements

Provide additional technology equipment for use in campus classrooms, computer labs, or other instructional spaces

Major Renovations & Additions

- Provide additional classroom space and/or replace portable classrooms
- Renovate existing classrooms and other instructional spaces as needed to meet standards established by **Texas Education Agency**
- Replace or improve existing science labs to meet instructional standards
- Add or renovate additional space for Special Education, as needed
- Replace or improve Fine Arts spaces for theatre and dance / pep squad / cheerleading
- Replace or improve practice gymnasium and associated support spaces
- Renovate space for teacher and administrative support, as needed
- Restore or replace existing mechanical, electrical, and plumbing systems in renovated areas
- Repair and renovate site issues, including parking lots and roadway around buildings, student-drop off locations, outdoor basketball courts, underground utilities, storm water control, and landscaping and irrigation

Vocation/Career Instruction


- New and/or renovated instructional spaces for the following programs: Urban Business Careers that include Construction Trades, Transportation, Culinary Arts, Printing and Imaging center, Animation and Cosmetology labs; Teacher Education; Criminal Justice; Architecture studio; Business, Marketing and Finance labs, Business Center and school store (also supports Business, Finance & Marketing magnet); and
- New and/or renovated shared spaces for career instruction and campus use, including a GO CENTER for college and career readiness


Athletic Track
