### **2010 Proposed Bond Projects**

#### Safety & Security Improvements

- Improve campus security and access control with additional security cameras, new building access cards and readers for faculty and staff
- Repair and update existing PA system, emergency fire alarm system, and fire sprinkler system in campus
- Improve special-needs accessibility issues
- Improve site lighting and fences

#### **Technology Improvements**

 Provide additional technology equipment for use in campus classrooms, computer labs, or other instructional spaces

#### **Major Renovations & Additions**

- Renovate existing classrooms and other instructional spaces as needed to meet standards established by **Texas Education Agency**
- Replace or improve existing science labs to meet instructional standards
- Add or renovate additional space for Special Education, as needed
- Replace or improve Fine Arts spaces for visual art, theatre, and dance / pep squad / cheerleading
- Replace or improve competition and practice gymnasiums, and associated support spaces
- Renovate space for teacher and administrative support, as needed
- Renovate space for Student Health Services (clinic)
- Restore or replace existing mechanical, electrical, and plumbing systems in renovated areas
- Repair and renovate site issues, including parking lots and roadway around buildings, student-drop off locations, outdoor basketball courts, underground utilities, storm water control, and landscaping and irrigation

#### **Vocation/Career Instruction**


- New and/or renovated instructional spaces for the following programs: Business, Marketing and Animation labs; Criminal Justice; Teacher Education; Hotel and Restaurant Management; Culinary Arts center; Cosmetology lab; Veterinary Science; Agricultural Mechanics, Horticulture and Floral Design; International Baccalaureate magnet; and JROTC
- New and/or renovated shared spaces for career instruction and campus use, including a GO CENTER for college and career readiness


#### Athletic Track


- Provide all-weather surfacing for existing campus track
