MSP Welcomes Back CISSA

Communities In Schools of San Antonio works in collaboration with the Middle School Partners Program to provide on-going case management services to Partners students working to assess student needs, develop and implement a plan to provide support and monitor progress. Communities In Schools’ Site Coordinators work to meet student needs by targeting one or more of six component areas: supportive guidance, academic assistance, parent and family engagement, enrichment, basic needs and career awareness.



Examples of the 6 service components provided by Site Coordinators include:

<p>Supportive Guidance and Counseling –Attendance monitoring, social skills groups, drug prevention activities, behavioral intervention sessions, and grief support counseling</p>	<p>Health and Human Services – Health fairs, hygiene items, community referrals, mobile food pantries, uniforms, school supplies and free eye care programs</p>
<p>Parent and Family Engagement – Parent coffees, home visits, conferences, newsletters, Parent Nights</p>	<p>College and Career Readiness - College field trips, career speakers, post-secondary goal exploration</p>
<p>Enrichment Activities – Field trips to art museum, Holocaust survivor speakers, community services activities,</p>	<p>Academic Support - Tutoring, note taking workshops, grade checks, testing strategies worksheets</p>
