On the night that Highlands hosts Eagle Pass in the season opener for high school baseball, we will be pleased to recognize:



Diz Reeves - a long-time District Athletic Director who was instrumental in building the SAISD Sports Complex. The primary baseball field at the sports complex will be named the Diz Reeves Diamond in his honor.



John "Mule" Miles - a 1941 graduate of Wheatley HS and a legendary professional baseball player in the Negro League in the 1940s. The District's indoor hitting facility will be named the John "Mule" Miles Hitting Barn in his honor.

The Highlands High School 1968 baseball team - The team will be honored on its 50th anniversary for winning the Class 4A state baseball championship. The Owls rolled to a memorable 24-3 overall record and won the highest UIL classification in baseball at the time. No other high school baseball team in San Antonio has won the state baseball championship in the highest classification since Highlands did it.
