If your save button is grayed out, [Restore settings to original defaults](#).

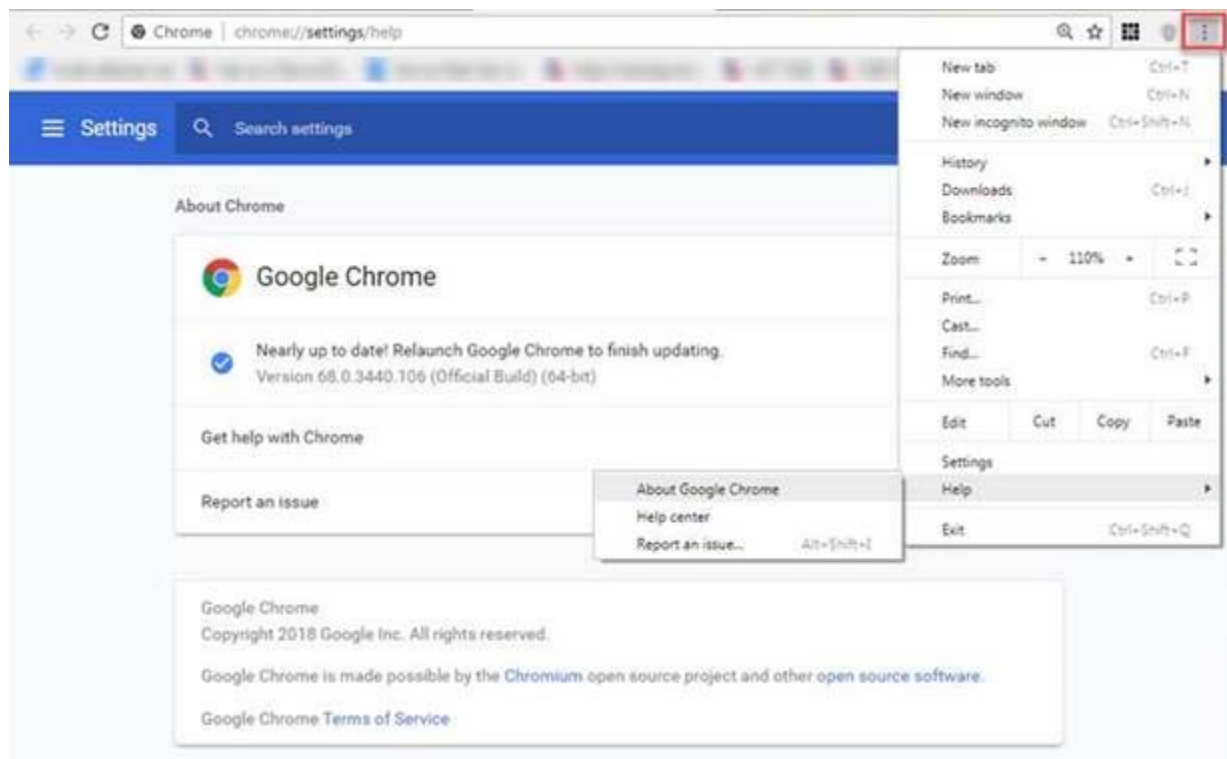
## Update Google Chrome

txGradebook needs the latest version of Chrome, sometimes all you need is to restart your computer. If restarting does not work follow the below instructions.

You can also run txGradebook in Internet Explorer.

Steps users can take to update their Google Chrome browser:

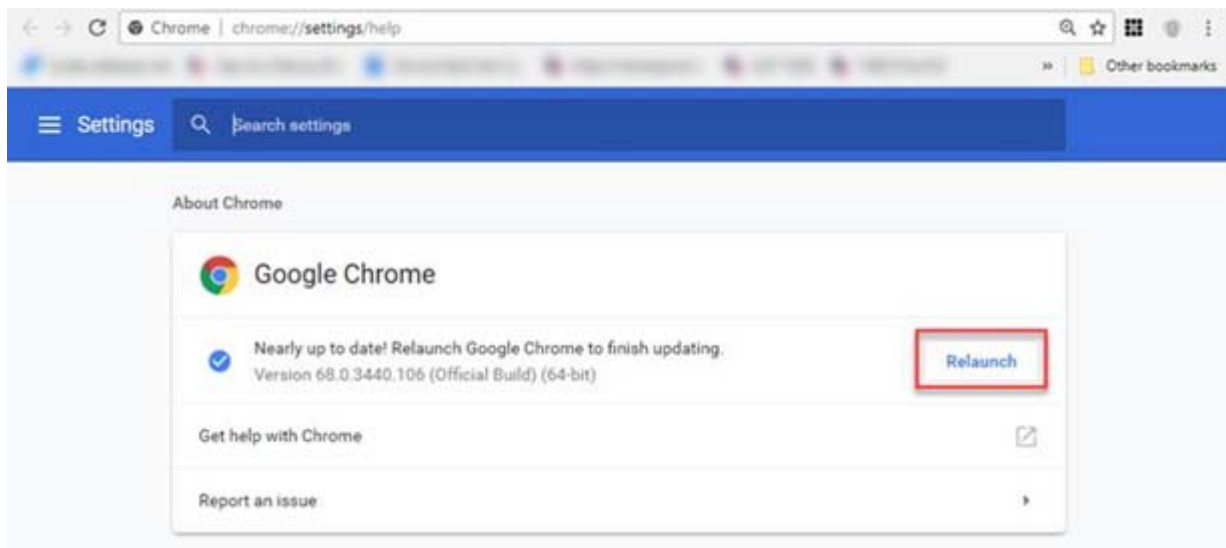
1. Open Google Chrome and select the Customize and control Google Chrome button ( ⋮ ).
2. Hover over Help and click on About Google Chrome.



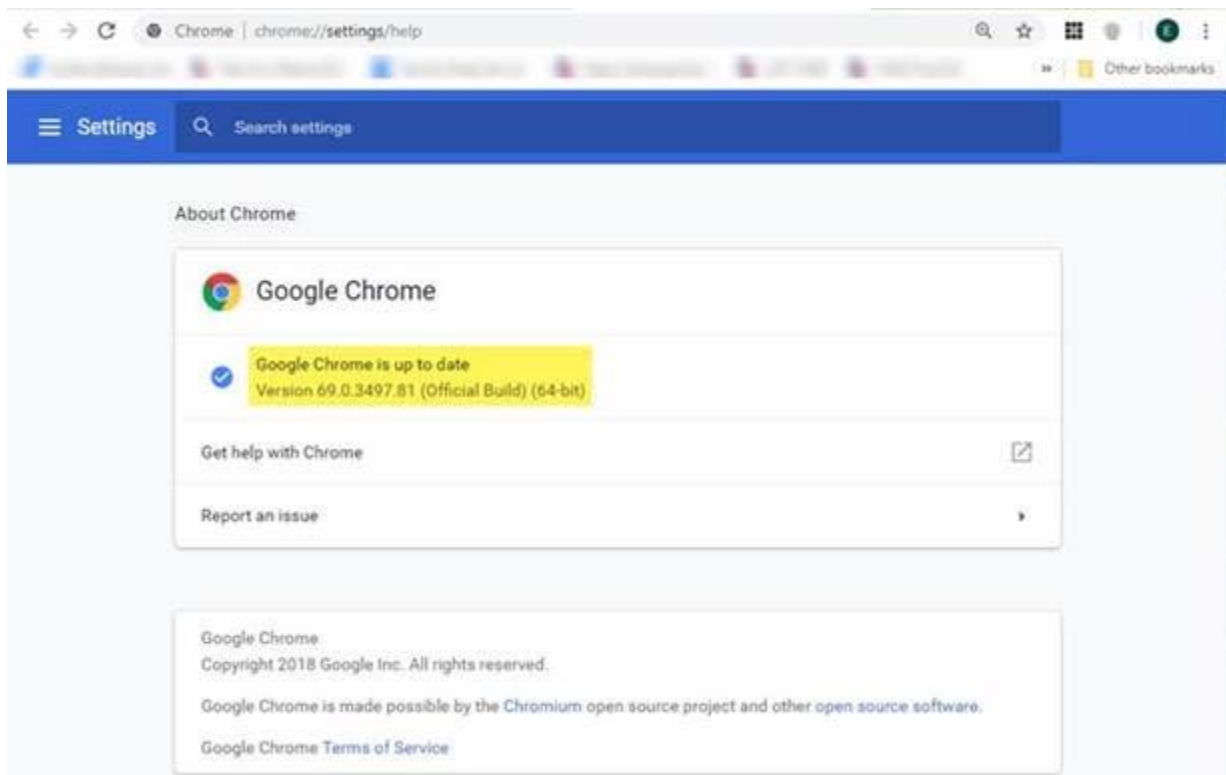
3. Google Chrome may run through an update process for several seconds (or a minute...) before a Relaunch button appears. You will see a % complete message while this is happening.

4. Click the Relaunch button

5. The Google Chrome relaunch process may take some time; allow Google Chrome to finish updating. The browser will restart and display the updated Version.

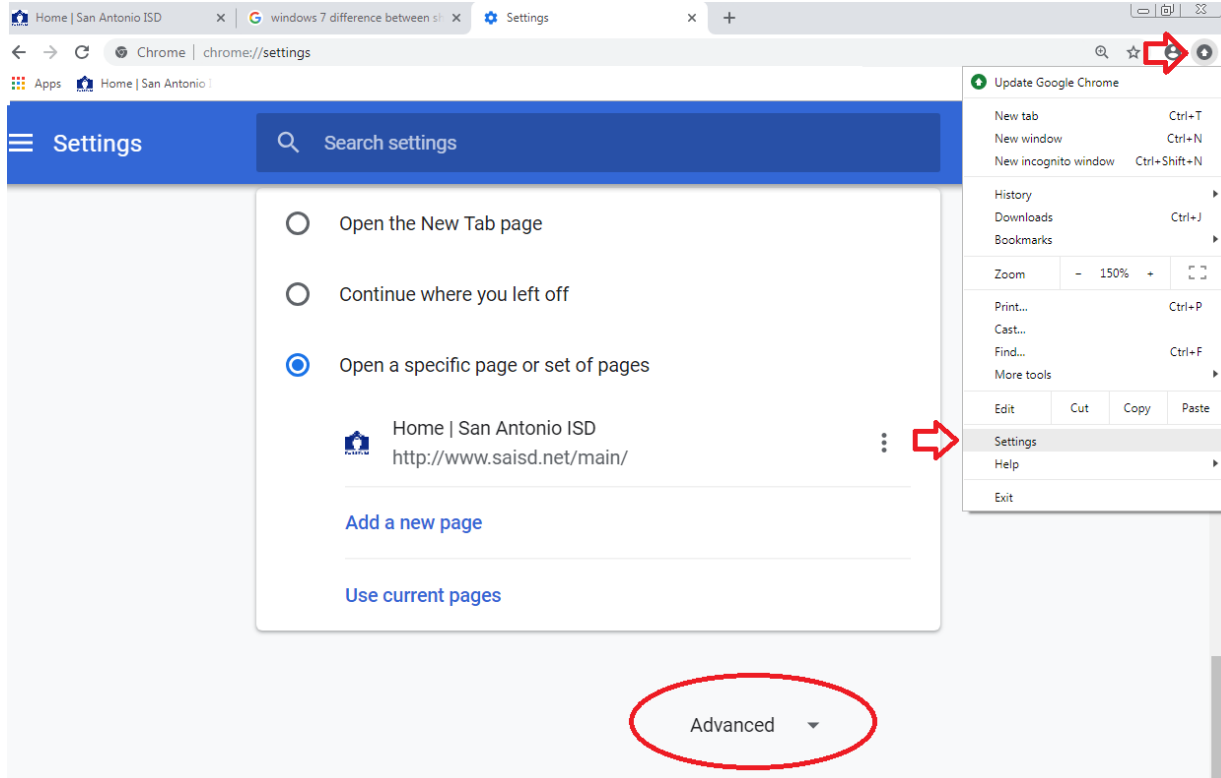


6. After the steps are completed restart your computer.

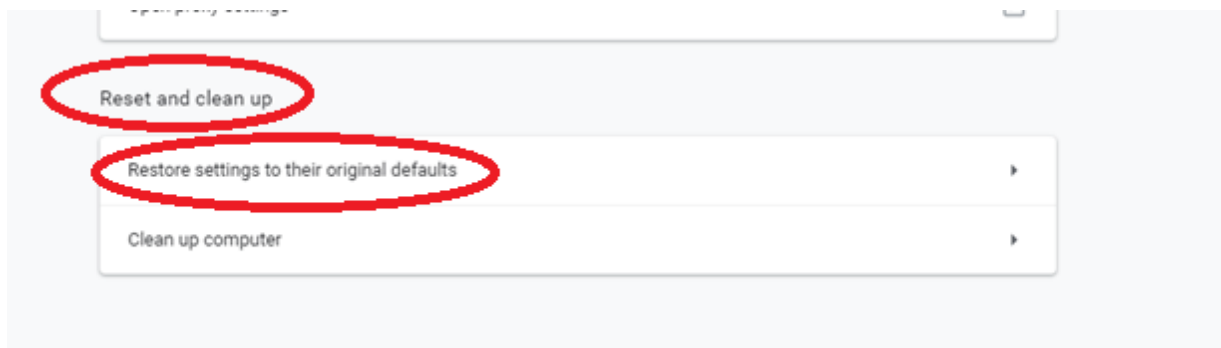
# Restore settings to original

Steps users can take to restore settings to original:

1. Open Google Chrome and select the Customize and control Google Chrome button ( ⋮ ).
2. Click on Settings then scroll down to Advance and click.



3. Look for the Reset and clean up section at the bottom. Click the Reset settings to their original defaults.



4. Click Reset settings
