SAN ANTONIO ISD COMMUNITY-BASED TASK FORCE Meeting #7 February 27, 2008

The sixth meeting of the Community-based Task Force was held on Wednesday, February 27, 2008, from 6:00 – 8:30 p.m. The agenda for the meeting is attached. Thirty-two community members and SAISD staff who are serving on the Task Force were in attendance.

Superintendent Robert Duron opened the meeting by thanking committee members for the investment of time, energy, and passion in the work. He pointed out the importance of the committee in light of the Board of Trustees' decision to close six schools at its meeting Monday evening. He encouraged everyone to continue with a focus on excellence, equity, and efficiency for student learning in SAISD.

The career technology group resumed their work on their beliefs and ideas about career technology programs and facilities and developed their Findings and Directions. Upon completion of that topic, the group worked on counseling and advisories. They completed their draft of the Findings and Directions as the meeting ended.

The safety and security and aging school facilities group completed their drafts of findings and directions on those topics. The group then discussed student storage, arriving at a single finding and direction to cover this topic.

The group working on special programs and staffing completed special programs and began the staffing work.

The committee agreed to set aside Wednesday, March 12 as an additional meeting to finalize the report before taking it forward to the Board. All committee members were invited to attend the Board of Trustees meeting on March 3.

The spokespersons who will give the update to the Board of Trustees on the work of the committee at the March 3, 2008 board meeting met after the regular meeting to review the outline of the presentation and divide responsibilities.
