WHAT IS AN ACCELERATED INSTRUCTION PLAN (AIP)?

An Accelerated Instruction Plan (also known as an Academic Intervention Plan) is a documented series of steps that a teacher plans to take to aid a student in getting back on an academic pathway toward success.

WHY DOES A STUDENT NEED AN AIP?

A student needs an AIP because research indicates that planned measures to rectify a student's learning need is the most efficient and effective path to recovering gaps of knowledge and/or skill sets.

Furthermore, true AIPs are rooted in evidence-based teaching practices; therefore, the state of Texas requires plans for the most vulnerable populations of students.

HOW DOES A TEACHER CREATE AN AIP AND THEN MONITOR PROGRESS?

A teacher can create an AIP by logging into Branching Minds and following the steps in this video: <u>link to video</u> (must be logged into Branching Minds).

These step-by-step (with screenshot) instructions can assist teachers in the creation of AIPs, too: <u>link to written instructions</u>.

A teacher can monitor a student's progress toward a goal in Branching Minds in many different ways. This video runs through the 3 most common different ways that a teacher may monitor a student's progress: <u>link to</u> <u>video</u>.


Remember: The teacher needs to select only one of the ways to monitor progress NOT all three.

WHO NEEDS AN ACCELERATED INSTRUCTION PLAN (AIP)?

ACCORDING TO THE LAW

The Texas Education Code requires teachers to create Accelerated Instruction Plans (AIPs) for public school students based upon varying academic needs. This chart from Region 13 will help you to determine which students require an AIP (those below): <u>link to the document</u>

WHERE AND WHEN DO ACCELERATED INSTRUCTION PLANS (AIPS) NEED TO BE ENTERED?

WHERE: AIPs SHOULD BE DOCUMENTED IN Branching Minds.

WHEN: AIPS SHOULD BE CREATED AS SOON AS AN ACADEMIC NEED IS MADE KNOWN TO THE TEACHER.
