

Edison, Fox Tech and Davis Middle School will be ready for move in during the third quarter of this year. Sam Houston High School, Irving Academy and J.T. Brackenridge Elementary School will be ready for move in during the fourth quarter 2020. Bowden Academy will be the first project completion during the first quarter, sometime around Spring Break, which is March 9-13.

Rogers Middle School

New era for south side community

The largest of the middle school projects, the new academic building for Rogers is well under construction with scaffolding and building materials visible from all angles around the campus.

Located on the southeast side at 314 Galway, a new three-story academic building will feature brand new classroom spaces, art and music areas, an auditorium, technology infrastructure and more. Principal Jane May is excited about the project and what it will do for the Rogers community.

“Students have been attending classes in this building for 60 years,” she said. “For our students to see the construction that’ll deliver brand new learning spaces, it tells them that they deserve a great environment

Half of the new building will be ready for students by the start of school in the fall.

Other highlights:

Brackenridge HS: Installation of flooring in second floor classrooms currently underway.

Burbank HS: District and school leaders continue mural preservation strategy.

Jefferson HS: Cafeteria work scheduled for completion and expected to be up and running by the end of the semester.

Lanier HS: Kitchen work to finish by the end of February. Rooftop mechanical systems are in place.

Tafolla MS: Construction on the outside progressing with steel canopies being installed.
