<u>Meet Conduct:</u> The meet will follow the National Federation order of events as described in the 2024-2025 Federation Swimming and Diving Rules book.

Date/Time: The District 27-5A Swimming and Diving competition will be held at the San Antonio Natatorium. On Wednesday, January 22, 2025 diving will start at 10 am and swimming will start at 11 am. All 11 dives will be contested at this time.

Location: San Antonio Natatorium is located at 1430 W. Cesar Chavez, San Antonio, Texas.

<u>Chairperson/Director/Officials:</u> The District 27-5A Chair is Orlando Vera. The District 27-5A Meet Director is Malachi Nellum, Aquatics Coordinator/Assistant Athletic Director-SAISD, and the Meet Referee is _SUE YOUNG_____.

<u>Meet Committee:</u> The District 27-5A swimming and Diving Meet Committee will be composed of all district coaches except the coach (es) involved in a particular incident/circumstance. The Meet Referee will also be a member of this committee.

Scoring: Individual and relay teams must compete in order to score points. The top eight will score points as per UIL.

Relays: 18 - 14 - 12 - 10 - 8 - 6 - 4 - 2Individuals: 9 - 7 - 6 - 5 - 4 - 3 - 2 - 1

The top six (6) swimmers/divers in each event (individual and relay) will advance to the UIL Regional VII Championship Swimming and Diving Meet to be held at Southwest ISD, February 7th and February 8th, 2025. State Meet will be held at University of Texas Aquatic Center, February 21-22, 2025.

<u>Awards/Honors:</u> Medals will be awarded to the top three contestants and ribbons for places 4-6 in each event. Plaques will be awarded to the first place team overall in both girls and boys divisions as per D.E.C..

District 27-5A First Team All District honors shall be awarded to the first place finishers in all individual and relay events. Second Team All District honors shall be awarded to all second place finishers in all individual and relay events. Honorable Mention All District honors will be given to third place finishers in all individual and relay events.

All Academic Teams will consist of all swimmers with a 90 or above average cumulative GPA (consisting of overall high school GPA).

Events: Each school may enter four individuals in any one single event. Teams may enter athletes in a maximum of four events; however, no athlete may participate in more than two individual events. Each school is limited to one team entry in each of the three relays offered in both the women's and men's competition. All events, including relays, will be held as timed finals. As per UIL, there are no exhibition swims allowed for District Championships. We will run a JV meet prior to our varsity meet consisting of the 50 free and 100 free for each gender if needed.

Entries: District 27-5A entries must be submitted to the meet director by Tuesday, January 15, 2025 no later than Noon. Entries must include the swimmer's full name, swimmer's school affiliation/grade and a seed time for either individual/relay events.

Please Note: All High Schools will be required to provide a minimum of two back up timers, which at least one will be a coach.

Relay order will be able to be changed up to the moment of the event as long as the athlete is on the relay card and has not exceeded his/her 4 events. If you scratch an individual from an individual event, it still counts as one of their 4 events.
