




REMINDERS

"This will be our third tax season hosted at CAST Tech and my sixth year supporting this program," VTTA Site Coordinator Lillian Garcia Bernal said. "I hope that student volunteers learn from this experience how to prepare taxes and how financial decisions will impact their return. I also hope that they will be able to see our community with a different perspective." The program assisted 146 taxpayers last year and has a goal of 200 this year.
