

'Beat the Heat' trips help 2022 grads with next steps Graduations finished June 15, but Postsecondary Initiatives has spent the second of June removing barriers between Class of 2022 graduates and college this fall. Running "Beat the Heat" bus trips between SAISD high schools and Alamo Colleges campuses, they've transported more than 70 graduates to Alamo Colleges sites helping students attend or sign up for orientation, get shot records turned in, send scores or retake the TSI test, meet with academic advisors, and meet with financial aid. classes this year have access to the AlamoPROMISE program, which provides last dollar funding to fill the gap between a student's financial aid award and the cost of tuition and mandatory fees for up to three years at one of the Alamo Colleges District's five colleges.
