





Hawthorne Academy received a new floor scrubbing machine this week. It is the first one to be delivered of 87 scrubbing machines the Facilities Department ordered for campuses across the district. The machines save time and reduce injuries from slippery floors and repetitive motion with hand mopping, and are part of the district's commitment to make sure team members have the right tools to do the job. The district has also ordered 87 floor buffing machines, 100 vacuums, 10 exterior window washing units, 60 restroom grout and wall cleaning machines, as well as wheeled waste transporting carts for every campus.





We learned this week, Mark Twain Dual Language Academy was ranked by U.S. News & World Report as being among the top 30% of elementary schools in the state of Texas based on its performance on state assessments and how well they prepare their students for high school. This qualifies Twain as a U.S. News Best Elementary School. Twain now stands alongside other SAISD ranked schools in the high school category:


