- San Antonio ISD has established and published Board Policies and Procedures to address discipline.
- No campus was identified based on evaluations conducted under the Safe and Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act (SDFSCA) of 1994.
- During the 2023-24 school year, there were 14 serious discipline offenses, requiring mandatory expulsion, recorded at 15 campuses.
