PRE-KINDERGARTEN ENROLLMENT TIMELINE

Neighborhood Campuses

Beginning April 1, 2019	4 year olds who qualify for ADA funding
Beginning August 19, 2019 (<i>previously Aug. 26</i>)	4 year olds who do not qualify for ADA funding
Beginning August 26, 2019 (<i>previously Sept. 3</i>)	3 year olds who qualify for ADA funding
Beginning September 3, 2019 (<i>previously Sept. 9</i>)	3 year olds who do not qualify for ADA funding

Gonzales Early Childhood Center

Beginning April 1, 2019	Any 3 & 4 year olds who qualify for ADA funding (in district ¹ or out of district ²)
Beginning August 19, 2019 (<i>previously Aug. 26</i>)	Any 3 & 4 year olds who do not qualify for ADA funding (in district ¹ or out of district ²)

¹ In district includes SAISD employees' children

² Out of district via Transfer Process

Choice Schools with Pre-Kindergarten

Beginning April 1, 2019	All students accepted through lottery (in district ¹ or out of district ²) Pre-K Qualification Form determines state-funded or non-state-funded status
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¹ In district includes SAISD employees' children

HEAD START ENROLLMENT TIMELINE

Beginning February 27, 2019	Accepting applications for all potential Head Start students Application and registration ongoing until all Head Start slots are filled
Beginning May 2019	90% of families notified of selection and Head Start campus
Beginning June 2019	8% of families notified of selection and Head Start campus
Beginning July 2019	Finalizing remaining 2% of Head Start enrollment

PRE-KINDERGARTEN QUALIFICATION

- To qualify for state-funded Pre-K, a student must meet at least one of the qualifications on the website below.
- Students that do not qualify for state-funded Pre-K will **not** be required to pay tuition upon enrollment.

PRE-KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS WHO DO NOT QUALIFY FOR STATE FUNDING

- Campuses are still responsible for identifying which students do or do not qualify for state funding through the already established PK Qualification process.
