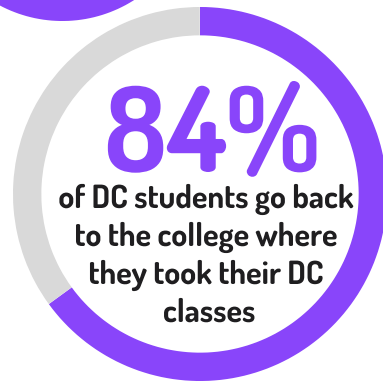
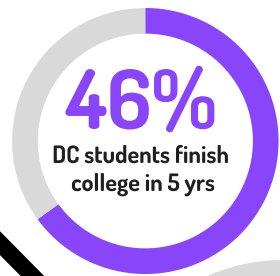


Why not go to College NOW? 2020-21

- How are you advising students as they select their dual credit courses? Will all courses apply to a degree plan?

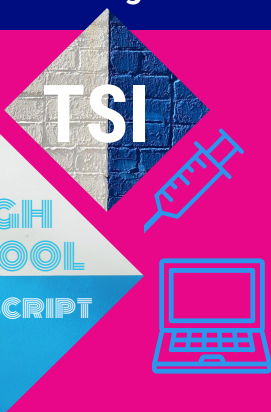
Be an SAISD Greehey Scholar

A Greehey Scholar will earn anywhere from 12+ college hours while still in high school.

- Level I: 12-18 college hours
- Level II: 21-29 college hours
- Level III: 30+ college hours

What your students need to do...

- Talk to their counselor
- Fill out the ApplyTexas application & complete the advising modules
- Get an updated Meningitis shot
- Meet TSI cut scores= R-351, M-350, W-340, 4-Essay
- Provide their High School Transcript



Support for students

Even though students may struggle with the rigor of the courses, tutoring with campus teachers or College tutors is always encouraged. Students should know who to contact on campus to get tutoring help.

Student should...

- Profess a willingness to work hard; can have a "C" avg or better
- Value Higher Education and pledge to meet College Readiness benchmark on TSI and/or SAT/ACT
- Demonstrate a commitment to attend college after high school with a goal of earning a professional degree/credential
- Follow requirements for completing set number of courses per grade: 9th=3 SCH, 10th=6 SCH, 11th=9 SCH, 12th=12 SCH
