- Cheerleaders and mascots in uniform as well as sponsors will NOT be charged admission to enter the Alamo Convocation Center (ACC)
- Please park and enter on the east side of the facility and locate the players' entrance. An ACC staff member will notify Barbara Wise upon your arrival to greet you and escort you inside.
- Cheerleaders are prohibited from cheering on the playing surface
- A limit of 12 cheerleaders will be permitted on the floor behind their team.
- Cheerleaders not performing on the floor during the match must be seated in the bleachers. All pep groups will be in the bleachers
- Cheerleaders are prohibited from tossing ANY spirit items into the stands or using signage that would impede the view of spectators
- Only cheerleaders are allowed to use megaphones for the purpose intended. Megaphones may not be used to pound on the floor, nor may they be used to orchestrate a loud noise to disrupt a server from the other team.
- Please be advised that leaving pom-poms on the floor may be a safety hazard for athletes making a play for the ball.
- The UIL does allow "Pep" bands to play at volleyball matches prior to the start of the set during warmups, time-

outs, and between sets. Pep Bands will be limited to no more than 10 members due to seating availability. Musical instruments are prohibited as artificial noisemakers. The "Pep" band should not be located behind or near the opposition's bench and there is an assigned section for them.

• If a "Pep" band does perform, the above guidelines should be followed to ensure a full appreciation of the group's performance. Band directors are reminded that as a courtesy to the teams and cheerleaders of both schools, performances by the pep band are limited to pre match warm ups and time outs only.
