


General Trainings

Recognizing and Reporting Child Abuse Virtually (1.5 hrs.)

A virtual training experience to assist educators and service providers in identifying and appropriately responding to possible signs of abuse and neglect during their virtual sessions.

What is Child Abuse? * (1.5 hrs.)

Provides a basic foundation for understanding, identifying, and reporting suspected child abuse.

Darkness to Light[®] Stewards of Children[™] Training* (2 hrs.)

This nationally recognized, evidence-based sexual abuse prevention curriculum trains adults to prevent, recognize, and react responsibly to child sexual abuse as well as motivating participants to action.

Love 146 Caregiver Training* (2 hrs.)

Develop a basic understanding of human trafficking, commercial sexual exploitation, and vulnerabilities. Participants will also learn about safety planning with youth and resources available.

Child Sexual Abuse: Victims & Offenders (1.5 hrs.)

A more in-depth look at victims and offenders of sexual abuse, allowing participants to walk away with a better understanding of the dynamics involved.

Sexual Behavior Problems in Children (1 hr.)

Learn to distinguish between healthy sexual development and maladaptive sexual behaviors while discussing appropriate procedures and responses.

Out and About Safety (45 min.)

Today, our children are facing many unseen dangers in the world. Give the children in your life safety tips for any setting through this workshop.

Learn the latest statistics, online resources, and expert tips to educate, engage, and empower children to be safer online and offline. Contains age appropriate tips, thought-provoking discussions, as well as candid, practical advice.

Identifying and Reporting Child Abuse*

Provides a basic foundation for understanding, identifying, and reporting suspected child abuse to educators, auxiliary staff, and volunteers working with children in schools, early childhood development centers, or youth-serving organizations.

Accident Prevention and Safety for Babies, Toddlers, & Teens

Watch interviews with local healthcare professionals and child safety experts outlining how to keep children safe from abuse and other preventable accidents.

* These trainings meet the requirements for *Texas Education Code § 38.0041* policies addressing *Sexual Abuse and Other Maltreatment of Children*. They have been approved by the Texas Department of State Health Services for both *Youth Camp and Campus Programs for Minors* training in accordance with 25 TAC 265.12(g) *Sexual Abuse and Child Molestation Awareness* training and examination program.

Training Fee's:

- Nonprofit Organizations: \$100 per hour

- For Profit Organizations: \$200 per hour
- Mileage reimbursement (outside Bexar County only): 55 cents per mile
- Cancellation/reschedule fee within 48 hours or less: \$25
