Questions to Check for Unit Understanding

- What is the theme or lesson you learned from reading the selection?
- Tell me what happened in the selection from start to finish.
- What point of view does the author use in the selection? First or third person?
- After finishing the selection How would you change the ending? Explain your answer.
- How did the images help you understand the reading?

- What do you think about the main character? What or who do they remind you of?
- Why do you think the author wrote this text?
- What message does the author communicate? Should you have learned a lesson? Why or why not?
