Key Academic Vocabulary

- Atmosphere: the layer of gases that surround the Earth
- Axis: an invisible line on which an object rotates or spins
- Composition: the materials that make up an object
- Orbit: one complete circular or oval-shaped path of one object around another
- Revolution: the movement of an object in a circular motion around a central point or axis
- Rotation: the turning or spinning of an object on its axis
