Key Academic Vocabulary

- Summarize: A brief statement of the main points of the text
- Main idea: The most important idea of a text or portion of text
- Plagiarize: Copy from someone and pass it off as one's own.
- Synthesize: Combine important information from a variety of texts and write in your own words.

Key Academic Vocabulary

- Inference: The act or process of reaching a conclusion about something from known facts or evidence
- Annotate: Adding notes to a text for summarizing and connecting ideas
- Central idea: The message the author is trying to get across to the reader
- Author's purpose: An author's reason for, or intent, in writing a text
