

## Some tips for parents

- Take notes and share information concerning your child with the teacher that could impact his/her learning (how your child learns best, personality, learning disabilities, personal information, etc.).
- Follow-up with your child's teacher every nine weeks to review his/her work, grades, and progress in school.
- Register on Parent Portal and Canvas to monitor/view your child's grades, attendance, and assignments online. Contact your child's school for more information.
- Think of ways you would like to be involved in your child's learning so that you can discuss them with the teacher.

## Questions to ask the teacher

1. Is my child making an effort to learn in your class?
2. Does my child come prepared for class?
3. Does my child turn in homework?
4. How does my child participate in class?
5. Do you offer tutoring before or after school?
6. How can I help my child at home?
7. What time is your conference period?
