Some tips for parents

- Take notes and share information concerning your child with the teacher that could impact his/her learning (how your child learns best, personality, learning disabilities, personal information, etc.).
- Follow-up with your child's teacher every nine weeks to review his/her work, grades, and progress in school.
- Register on Parent Portal and Canvas to monitor/view your child's grades, attendance, and assignments online. Contact your child's school for more information.
- Think of ways you would like to be involved in your child's learning so that you can discuss them with the teacher.

Questions to ask the teacher

- 1. Is my child making an effort to learn in your class?
- **2.** Does my child come prepared for class?
- 3. Does my child turn in homework?
- **4.** How does my child participate in class?
- **5.** Do you offer tutoring before or after school?
- 6. How can I help my child at home?
- **7.** What time is your conference period?
