Student Learning Targets

Key Academic Vocabulary

- Inference: A conclusion reached on the basis of evidence and reasoning.
- Textual evidence: Selected words or phrases from a text that support an inference, claim, or predictions.
- Annotate: To record thinking as you read in order to enhance your understanding of a text.

Key Academic Vocabulary

- Context: The words or phrases within or beyond a sentence that help us determine the meaning of unknown words.
- Comprehension: The ability to process a text and understand its meaning
- Plot: The basic sequence of events in a story includes the beginning, rising action, climax, falling action and resolution.
