
A teacher's Master Teacher Initiative 3.0 eligibility category is determined by the teacher's role during their data collection year. Teachers will have only one category to determine eligibility for MTI 3.0. Teachers who have more than one eligibility category based on the courses they are assigned, will default to the applicable category in this order:

- 1.STAAR/EOC
- 2.APA/MAP/Circle
- 3. Student Learning Objective(SLO)




MTI 3.0 Eligibility Categories





MTI 2.0 Eligibility

Teachers

- TTESS two year average of 3.3 (TTESS minimum score will increase to 3.5 for the 2023-24 school year to maintain eligibility)*
- Student Growth- Minimum of 50%
- The teacher was employed and compensated (or will be by the end of the school year) for a creditable year of service in a teaching role (087 role ID)
 - 50% or more of the day for a minimum of 180 days
 - 100% of the day for a minimum of 90 days, or the equivalent of one semester

<u>Students</u>

- Minimum of 10 Students with appropriate pre-test
- Enrolled during Fall and Winter snapshot
- 70% attendance

* SAISD's MTI designation requirements will incrementally increase the TTESS minimum score over the next two years to 3.7 by the 2024-25 school year to be in alignment with the TEA TIA guidelines.

MTI 3.0 Eligibility

All new and renewal designations from 2023-24 and after will be evaluated under the MTI 3.0 criteria.

<u>Teachers</u>

- TTESS one year average of 3.5*
- Student Growth- varies depending on teacher role
- The teacher was employed and compensated (or will be by the end of the school year) for a creditable year of service in a teaching role (087 role ID)
 - 50% or more of the day for a minimum of 180 days
 - 100% of the day for a minimum of 90 days, or the equivalent of one semester

<u>Students</u>

- Minimum of 10 Students with appropriate pre-test
- Enrolled during Fall and Winter snapshot
- 70% attendance
