The growth in SAISD is due in part to the dedication of Master Teachers who share the belief that the leader in front of the classroom, more than any other factor, has the ability to affect student outcomes.



The SAISD Master Teacher Initiative partners experienced teachers with a proven track record of success with vulnerable students, moving them from "at risk" to "at promise." The goal is to accelerate a student's learning with the support of a champion who will help them reach his or her maximum potential. That starts with a team of dedicated professionals who have the extra time and support they need to do their best work with the students who need them most.



Commitment. Work closely with our most at-risk students in an Extended Day schedule, usually an additional 5 hours a week.



Growth. Spend 20 additional days at school throughout the year, 10 with children and 10 in professional learning.



Compensation. Earn up to **\$15,000** above your regular salary for the additional time and days worked, plus stipends for secondary math or science teachers, bilingual teachers, and special education teachers.



Opportunity. Pursue tuition-free advanced degrees at one of our four higher education partners: Relay Graduate School, UTSA, OLLU, and Texas A&M San Antonio.
