Note: Not all of the SAT's below 600 and ranks below 10% represent "slots" for our students with marginal numbers. Many or most are probably athletes (particularly at D1 schools) and legacies. Also, a college with a low percentage below 600 on SAT reading but a higher percentage not in the top 10% probably draws heavily from elite prep schools where there are lots of high-achieving students not ranked in the top 10%.
